### **Free Lessons for Asylum Seekers and Refugees**

English in the Community (EITC), is a new Charity which provides innovative English language lessons for local immigrants. The organisation has recently received funding which allows it to offer free lessons for Asylum Seekers and Refugees. This offer applies to those with skills ranging from Beginner to Upper-Intermediate level. A limited number of places are available - phone now for further details.

### **Special Free Lessons for Beginners**

EITC is also introducing a special programme for Beginners who speak no English or only a few words. The course is free for Asylum Seekers or Refugees. For other students the first two lessons will be provided free of charge, thereafter there is a charge of £20 for a four week course.

The price includes all books and materials. The free lessons are part of a special Beginners programme EITC has set up to help students who are struggling to be understood. The teacher uses a special intensive method which concentrates on speaking and listening, while building confidence. Most students can speak and understand a few phrases after just one or two lessons.

Classes are held at the **Community Information Centre, 16 Silchester Road, St. Leonards**, and at convenient town centre locations in Hastings. Students will need to come for an interview before starting.
